

# KEN BLAIN'S LATEST COMPETITION FIGHTER KITE

## TALON III



### **A little about me:**

I'm, Terry McPherson, a friend of Ken Blain's and since I'm retired and have some time, I offered to assist Ken in the marketing of his hot new Talon III fighter kite.

Basically, I'm the contact person you email to get more details about Ken's kites. I'm also the one who will package and mail the kites.

Our thinking is that if a person emailed wanting more details, prices, availability, etc., they would probably like a reply reasonably soon. Since I have more time than Ken, I offered to handle this aspect for Ken.

### **A little about Ken:**

Ken Blain, is a kite maker from Ada, MI, he has been very active in kiting for the last 16-17 years and is a very good kite maker.

For the last 6- 7 years he has been involved with flying and competing with fighter kites and that led him to designing and making fighters. In recent years Ken has been in the winners' circle of most fighter kite line touch competitions he's entered!

Ken's a versatile kite maker; he works with Toray Polyester, poly-films of various types and Orcon to produce competition caliber fighter kites. The latest of his masterpieces is the Talon III.

### **A little about Talon III:**

This is an extremely durable competition fighter kite PLUS its color and graphics make it a beauty in the sky! Because the Toray Polyester is almost indestructible, this kite is one that will give years of flying enjoyment! Plus you can enjoy flying the Talon III in a wide range of wind speeds! Ken designed the Talon III to perform well in most 'normal' wind speeds; however, it won't fly well in zero wind unless you are an especially skilled flyer and it won't fly well in winds above 14 MPH.

Each Talon III is precisely handcrafted and signed by Ken Blain and has a Toray Polyester sail with machine sewn appliqué. The kite measures 19 ¾" W x 16" H. The 0.05" diameter carbon fiber bow, hand shaped bamboo spine and the 4-0.03" diameter carbon fiber battens are glued and taped to the Toray sail. The bridle on the Talon III is a 3-point, fully adjustable, bridle made of 20# Dacron line.

**The purchase price for a Talon III is \$35 USA dollars plus \$5 packaging and shipping! When you purchase more than one Talon III mailed to the same address, the price is \$35 per kite plus \$5 total for packaging and shipping.**
